Ears To Hear

Fifteen times Jesus said, "He who has ears to hear, let him hear" or, "He who has an ear, let him hear" (Matthew 11:15; Revelation 2:7 et. al.). Possessing ears doesn't guarantee that you have "ears to hear" (i.e. that you are of a mind to listen, understand, and heed what is said).

Luke 6:17 tells of a great crowd from numerous places coming for the specific purpose of hearing Jesus. At the close of His earthly ministry the common people in the temple "were very attentive to hear Him," frustrating the efforts of the Sanhedrin to kill Him then (Luke 19:47-48). And in Acts 13:7 the governor Sergius Paulus "called for Barnabas and Saul and sought to hear the word of the Lord.



In stark contrast, when the Sanhedrin heard the plain truth about Jesus from Stephen, "they cried out with a loud voice, stopped their ears, and ran at him with one accord; and they cast him out of the city and stoned

him" (Acts 7:57-58). Ironically, the same Saul who headed that mob later preached Christ to Sergius Paulus (see above)! Better known as Paul, he warned Timothy that "the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; and they will turn away their ears from the truth, and be turned aside to fables" (2 Timothy 4:3-4).

Which of the two preceding paragraphs best describes you? Do you have "ears to hear," or "itching ears"? Are you "very attentive to hear," or does plain truth make you stop your ears? What appeals to you more, sound doctrine or fables? Think about it!
